About College: Tilak Dhari College is one of the premier institutions not only in Uttar Pradesh but also in India. It has about 200 well-qualified teachers. There are above 12000 students in this college. The college is known for its innovative methods of teaching and the quality of its research work. The college was originally founded as an English Middle School in 1914 by Sri Tilak Dhari Singh. It was recognized as Kshatriya High School in 1916. It became Intermediate in 1940 and developed to the status of a Degree College in July 1947. The college, further, acquired the status of Post Graduation in 1970.

About Seminar: Inclusion of the students in between age group of 3 to 18 years is the excellent part of the policy. After 34 years such change took place in education system which covers all levels of education (from preparatory to research). Quantity and quality both are focused equally. Content (what will be taught) according to need of the 21st century and pedagogy (methods of teaching) both are intelligently planned to attract foreign students and to promote Indian students to study in the Country. Flexibility in all respects is preferred. 5+3+3+4 introduced, removing 10+2, is more fair, just and scientific. Concept of single regulator proposed in NEP 2020 will be more useful, time saving and cost effective. Roadmap for the entire education system proposed in these new guidelines will certainly (if other things remaining the same) be a game changer. Some other appreciable initiatives are like--1- Integration of Arts with STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics) is an excellent initiative, it will promote imagination, innovation and higher order critical thinking. 2- Establishment of MERUs (Multi-Disciplinary Educational and Research Universities) will be useful in providing the facilities of flexibility and multi level entry and exit. Nothing is negative in this policy except NIYAT (How honest we are and will be at all levels?) Only implementation is the issue which requires discussion and debate and this is everything for the success of these guidelines. Effective implementation of the policy requires sufficient fund to shape the required level of physical and digital infrastructure along with honest practice and strong 'will power'. This forum will discuss the fate of this policy in actual situations in which we are residing.
